Water District

The Kiowa-Loop project that was started in October was completed in mid November. The project came in under budget and ahead of schedule; many thanks to the homeowners who granted the Water District special easements across their properties.

Due to the upcoming holidays, the Water Board meeting that for December was been from the regularly scheduled meeting date of December 23rd to December 10th. The Mil was certified for the coming year at this meeting. We are pleased to announce that the Mil Levy amount for collection in 2016 will be 37.272 down 5.566 Mil from last year.

The Water District has a new Board member. Resident Larry Wisecup was appointed to the vacant Board member seat at the November meeting.

Fire District

The mill levy to provide partial funding for the PSFPD Fire Station & Community Center project was officially certified by Larimer County on November 18th. The count was 203 yes, 197 no. The response rate was 68% of 587 ballots issued. The Fire Board and Construction Project Team submitted our DOLA grant application for matching funds on December 1, 2015 - notice of award will be in April 2016.
