The Pinewood Springs Fire Department is currently accepting applications for volunteers interested in serving their community. Training is provided in structure firefighting, wildland firefighting, emergency medicine, vehicle extrication, and hazardous materials response. Come to one of our maintenance sessions (3rd Tuesday of the month at 1900hrs (7:00pm) or one of our training sessions (4th Tuesday of the month at 1900hrs-7:00 pm) to learn more and to pick up an application packet.

With the recent windstorms, there is the possibility of damage to your property that could cause a fire or injury hazard. Chimney caps are sometimes damaged in high winds. Other vents can also become damaged or obstructed. Branches and broken trees can be dangerous if they have not fallen completely to the ground.
