

## **Pinewood Springs Newsletter** **November 2015**

### **Water District**

The Water District has started the Kiowa Loop project, which will connect the waterline at the end of Kiowa to the one at the end of Cree. The route was prepared on October 26<sup>th</sup> and blasting the rock occurred the rest of the week. Actual construction begins this week with an estimated completion time to be in 3 to 4 weeks, weather permitting. This project is being paid for by a grant from the Colorado Department of Health and Environment.

Due to the upcoming holidays, the Water Board meetings for both November and December have been changed from the regularly scheduled meeting dates. November's meeting will be Thursday the 19<sup>th</sup>. It will also include a Special Hearing to review the 2016 Budget. The December meeting will be held on Thursday, December 10<sup>th</sup>. It is held early in December to allow the Board to submit the Mil certification before the 15<sup>th</sup> of December as required by the Larimer County Commissioners.

### **Fire District**

### **Road Board**

The Road District has finished their final road repair project for this year, which was the area on Iroquois. Next spring we will cap and shape that area with road base. In the last few weeks we have made repairs to Kiowa Island, Sioux, and Wichita. John is cleaning up the culvert inventory, and road condition spread sheet. In preparation for winter: We have put up snow poles, and filled sand barrels. Next week we will put up snow fence, chain up trucks and mount snowplows. All the trucks have been serviced, and should be ready to go. We should have a list of road projects for next year ready for our next meeting, which we can discuss and finalize. Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup> our next bi-monthly meeting is at 7:00 behind the fire station – please come to the back. All residents are welcome!
