Cool weather will be upon us soon. Before lighting your woodstove or fireplace, be sure the chimney flue has been cleaned and inspected. Also replace batteries in your smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detector. The autumn time change is a good reminder to do these checks. After that, check them monthly by pressing the test button.

### Road Board

The Road Board is preparing for winter. This month we will begin installing snow fences on the west side of 36 to reduce drifting on our roads. We will also be installing additional marker posts along all the roads to identify hazards for our plow drivers. These hazards include ditches, culverts and obstructions such as rocks that are difficult to see while plowing. These hazards can cause damage to our equipment and potential harm to our drivers. Please do not remove these markers. Most of the markers will be removed at the end of the snow season.

Again this year, the Cherry Company Store is allowing our winter commuters to park in portions of their lot. Do not park along the roads. Parked cars can limit our ability to clear snow from the roads and pose a hazard to the equipment. Thanks for your cooperation.
