Water District

The water line replacement project on Deer Lane and Deer Hollow Court is progressing. We hope to have it finished by mid August. The line being replaced is one of the oldest in the Pinewood Springs area and was the one giving us the most trouble. It has been on the line replacement list since before the flood. The Water District would like to thank all the residents in that area for their patience.

Our new meter reading system is very effective in registering small leaks at residential services. In the past two months, there have been ten such leaks. Last month they were 4 on the south side of 36 and this month they are 4 on the north side. Three of the leaks this month are clustered close together on Wichita. Last month, there were several together in the vicinity of Pinewood Dr, Apache and Cherokee. This would seem to indicate a possible seismic shift. Did anyone feel the ground moving?
