### Water District

The Water District phone is answered 24/7. If you experience a major leak or see one occurring in the community, please call us at 303-823-5345. We don't monitor emails after hours or check social media, but we do answer the phone. The leak this past week was on a main line, started at about 3:00 am and poured out approximately 20,000 gallons before it was reported by several alert residents. Another leak indicator to be aware of is lower water pressure than you normally have. We have several small divisions within our larger system. The pressure on the north side could be fine, while the south side could be experiencing low pressure indicating a leak somewhere in that division. It's important that we know about this.
