The Pinewood Springs Fire Protection District is seeking volunteer firefighters. Successful candidates must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Reside within the boundaries of the PSFPD service area
- Possess a valid Colorado driver's license
- Pass a criminal background and motor vehicle record check
- Pass an oral review and a strength/mobility/aptitude task-based evaluation

Previous experience is not required. All training, gear and equipment is provided by the fire district. The increased system improvement fee of \$23.25 was implemented with this billing. Usage over 3000 gallons has been increased to \$1.00 per 100 gallons. In case you missed it, the mill levy to be collected in 2018 is 29.191% down from last year's 37.106%. The tap fee for 2018 is \$36,883.49. Please consider placing your outdoor lights on a motion detector sensor. They are fairly inexpensive and just screw into your light socket between the bulb and the socket. With motion detection lights, one always knows when a critters or trespassers approach, because your lights come on and give you a clear shot.
