### Property Owners Association

Many residents have voiced concern regarding the recently announced and proposed power line upgrades in the Estes Park area. Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) has proposed changes to the transmission lines that run from Estes Park to Flatiron Reservoir. In spite of the name "Estes-Lyons Tap", it is our understanding that these upgraded power poles will **NOT** be coming through Pinewood Springs. The lines follow a route from the Estes power substation across Lake Estes and then up to Meadowdale Hills and on to Pole Hill. At that point they continue due east to Flatiron Reservoir. This route will take them approximately 4 miles north of Pinewood as the crow flies. A map of the proposed upgrades will be posted on our new Bulletin Board.
