### Water District

A possible change to the Rules and Regulations concerning the fees and fines for those residents using over 6000 gallons during a billing period is on the agenda for a special hearing to be held prior to the next meeting. Up for discussion will be the following: Should the Fine System stay as is? Should the fees be lowered? Should there be no requirement to attend a Board meeting? Under this new billing tier, there should also be no adjustments to your bill should you exceed 6000 gallons, no matter what the reason. The only exception might be a line leak between the house and the meter. The Board is trying to ensure that the homeowner be responsible for keeping their plumbing in good repair and for keeping their usage under 6000 gallons per month. Also, up for discussion is an increase to the zero to 6000-gallon rate structure.
