Water District

The Board of Directors would like to remind everyone that according to our water decree, there is absolutely no outside water usage allowed. This means you cannot water your flowers, shrubs or trees with treated water. Water use violations could result in a disconnection of water service. Our Water Super, James, will be sampling for lead and copper in the next few weeks. The State has designated 10 or so older homes as test sites. You should have already been notified by the State. Expect to see James at your door soon!

Our PWS Road Board advises the county on work requirements and the county contracts the work.
