Due to the high temperatures, lack of rain and higher than normal usage, the level of the Little Thompson is dropping. Please be mindful of your daily usage, conserving whenever possible.

There seems to be some confusion about the reservoir and outside water usage. Just because the reservoir is full, does not mean the *no outside watering* rule goes away. The Water Augmentation Plan granted by the State of Colorado will always be in effect. It is that document that states the residents of Pinewood Springs may NOT use any treated water outside. This includes any activity that requires you hook a hose to an outside faucet, such as yard watering, car washing, deck washing and so on. Water is and will continue to be a very precious commodity.
