The Consumer Confidence report for 2016 is included in this month's water bill. Please let us know if you have any questions. Also, this is the time of year that our water supply takes on a yellowish tinge. The slight color change comes from the tannins in the water and is harmless. This usually happens in the spring after heavy rain and snow.

After some extensive research, the 2017 tap fee has been adjusted. The recalculated tap fee of \$34,235.70 ties back to the 2005 tap fee.
