Fire District

The Fire Department would like to remind residents who plan to burn slash on their property to please read the Larimer County Open Burning Ordinance. In particular, please note the following excerpts:

Slash: Woody material **less than six inches in diameter** consisting of limbs, branches, and stems that are free of dirt. "Slash" does not include tree stumps, roots, or any other material.

Open burns of slash piles are allowed only when there are predicted or actual **winds of 10 mph or less**.

All open slash-pile burns conducted above 6000-feet in elevation are **required to have three or more inches of snow on the ground around the slash**, unless an Air Curtain Destructor is used.

Open burn fires must be **constantly and directly attended** and observed by a competent and non-physically/mentally impaired person. Appropriate extinguishing equipment must be available and ready for immediate use.

The **Open Burn Permit must be in possession of the person attending and observing the open burn at all times**. The ordinance and other information can be accessed online at <https://www.larimer.org/health/clean-air-water-and-soil/air-quality/burn-permits>

Please assure safe burning in Pinewood Springs by carefully following the ordinance and associated guidelines. Contact the Pinewood Springs Fire Department if you have questions.
