Road Board

The Pinewood Springs Road Crew will be making a two-week assault on the 12 road sites identified by FEMA and the county engineers for flood repairs under a contract the county awarded to us and our contractor Bladeworks. A smaller portion of the roadwork will be completed later this summer in the bridge-repair areas.

Over the last couple of weeks we have been stockpiling material near the mailboxes and in the bins near the firehouse for these repairs. There will be significant equipment activity in the stockpile areas and on our roads for up to 12 hours a day. Please respect the orange cones and do not park or obstruct these areas while the work is being done. There will be significant activity at the storage areas and near the repair sites.
