Water District

Good news! The Water District has paid off a loan. This means that we will be able to reduce the mil levy that is to be collected in 2018. Using Larimer County's certification of valuation for 2017, we are happy to announce the mil levy will be set at the December meeting at 29.191, down from the 37.106 collected last year.

At the November Special hearing and Water Board meeting, after input from several residents, the Board voted to increase the System Improvement Fee by \$2.25 and the rate for usage over 3000 gallons by \$.05 per 100 gallons.
